CUMBRIA CENTRE RALLY RULES

(As amended 2nd October 2011 AGM)

- 1. Any site or part on which a rally is held shall be exclusively for the use of the Caravan Club.
- 2. The Centre Committee may refuse any member and its outfit, without being obliged to give a reason.
- 3. The Rally Officer, or their deputy, is responsible for the conduct of the Rally, and in the event of a member breaking the rules, has authority to request that member to remove themselves and their outfit from the site, and thereupon the Rally Officer must report the matter in writing immediately to the Committee for such action as shall be deemed necessary.
- 4. All members and visitors must report to the Rally Officer on first arrival on the site and must be prepared to produce their current membership card if so requested.
- 5. The pitch allocated by the Rally Officer or their deputy must be accepted.
- 6. Unless paid in advance, all fees must be paid on arrival on the site.
- 7. At the end of the Rally all outfits must be removed from the site, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Rally Officer.
- 8. Members must provide their own toilet facilities on all rallies. Toilet tents must be pitched where indicated by the Rally Officer.
- 9. Small tents in lieu of awnings are allowed at the discretion of the Rally Officer and in the event must be pitched where indicated.
- 10. Open fires on the Rally Field are only allowed with the Rally Officer's consent.
- 11. All waste must be disposed of as directed by the Rally Officer.
- 12. Only qualified drivers are allowed to drive on the Rally Site.

Speed limit is 5 mph.

- 13. Animals must be tethered on a lead not more than 2m long and secured near the door side road wheel. Owners are responsible for clearing up any mess.
- 14. The receipt of the booking slip and fee by the date requested by the Rally Officer shall be pre-requisite for the supply of plaque. No member shall be entitled to a plaque unless he attends with their caravan.
- 15. No booking will be acknowledged unless requested with SAE
- 16. Unless otherwise stated, all rallies commence at 5.00 pm. No arrivals are allowed before their time without prior consent of the Rally Officer.
- 17. For the comfort of others, all radios, TVs etc., must be operated at reasonable volume at all times.
- 18. Except for those rallies requesting special booking arrangements, which will be published in the Handbook, all rally booking slips must be accompanied by a £5 non-returnable booking fee. This fee will be deducted from the cost of the rally to be paid on arrival.
- 19. When a plain yellow flag is flown on the Rally Field, vehicles must not be moved without permission of the Rally Officer.
- 20. The use of private generators is allowed for a maximum period of two hours between the hours of 10am and 6pm. Generators must be used with consideration for other ralliers and must not be left unattended at any time when in use

This restriction will not apply to Rally Officers who need the use of a generator for activities and amenities as part of the rally. Use may be allowed outside of these stated hours in case of medical need, at the discretion of the Rally Officer.

CUMBRIA CENTRE PROCEDURAL RULES

(as amended 6th October 2019 AGM)

These Procedural Rules were originally passed by the membership at the Cumbria Centre AGM on 22nd October 1995, and incorporate amendments agreed at subsequent Annual or Special General Meetings held up to 3rd October 2010. These rules should be read in conjunction with the Rules Governing Centers and The Caravan Club Bye-laws (neither of which can be amended by the Centre), and Cumbria Centre Rally Rules (which can be amended by The Centre Committee). Rules Governing Centers and Caravan Club

Bye-laws can be found in the current edition of The Caravan Club Sites Directory. Cumbria Centre Rally Rules are printed in the Rally Book.

"The Committee" referred to in these Procedural Rules shall include all Centre Officers and Committee Members

- 1. The Officers of the Centre shall be the Chairman, the Secretary and the Treasurer. Of the other Committee posts, the post of Vice-Chairman and Rally Secretary will be nominated posts for election at AGM.
- 2. No Member may be elected to fill more than one of the Officer places on the Committee.
- 3. Every Committee Member must be a Full, Joint or Family Centre Member of the Caravan Club and registered as such with The Cumbria Centre.
- 4. The Officers and Committee shall retire annually and stand for re-election at each AGM if they wish to continue on Committee.
- 5. There is no statutory limit to the time Committee Members or Officers hold a post, with the exception of the Chairman's post which is limited to a maximum of three years.
- 6. A prospective Chairman should not be considered unless he or she has had at least 12 months experience of committee of any centre (of the Caravan Club). In the event of no nomination for Chairman, and the Vice-Chairman not being able or willing to take up the post, a Past Chairman should be co-opted by the Committee to be caretaker Chairman until an Extraordinary General Meeting is held once a proposal for Chairman is received. The initial approach by the Committee should be to the most recent Past Chairman and would move back in order until the post was filled.
- 7. Not more than two members of a household may stand for election to The Committee at any one time.
- 8. Nominations for the Committee must be with the Secretary (midnight) fourteen full days prior to the AGM.
- 9. The Officers and Committee must not sign each other's nomination for election or re-election.
- 10. The Secretary must check the validity of nominations as soon as possible after receipt, and inform nominees of any discrepancies in order to correct any anomalies.
- 11. A current list of nominations for The Committee will be announced at flag from six weeks before AGM.
- 12. Only Caravan Club members, Joint and Family members who are also Cumbria Centre members may vote or speak at any meeting, after first being confirmed as registered with Cumbria Centre. Validity of Cumbria Centre membership will be checked via the most recent Caravan Club computer printout. Hand-held "Vote and Talk" cards will only be issued to those who have been validated as Full, Joint or Family Cumbria Centre Members.
- 13. In the event of an election for Committee the following should be adhered to. "Election for Committee should be by ballot, and the Secretary should have ready suitable slips of paper. Two or more tellers should have been appointed in readiness. They should be responsible and discreet persons who have no interest in the result and are willing to miss the proceedings for some minutes. Tellers must be Caravan Club Members, Joint or Family members and if possible should not be members of Cumbria Centre. The tellers should report the result to the Chairman and votes should not be disclosed.
- 14. All unopposed valid nominations must be announced as such to the AGM and if accepted by the membership the nominees are automatically elected.
- 15. Proxy voting is not allowed.
- 16 The Auditor shall be named at the AGM for acceptance by the membership.

- 17. In the event of the Chairman or Vice-Chairman not being in attendance at any official meeting the Chair will be taken by any Officer or Committee member agreed by the Officers and Committee members present.
- 18. Cheque signatories must not be related or members of the same household.
- 19.(a) Whilst on official Committee business all Officers and Committee members are eligible to claim recompense of out of pocket expenses for postage, telephone calls and mileage allowance.
- (b) The Chairman may claim travelling expenses incurred during their or her attendance at an official invitation rally, excluding the first 100 miles travelled, and subject to a maximum of £25.00 per rally.
- 20. Committee meetings shall be held not less than five times a year, with a reasonable distribution throughout the year.
- 21. A Committee guorum shall consist of more than half the Committee, but no less than four.
- 22. The Secretary will pass appropriate information from the minutes of Committee meetings for publication on the web.
- 23. An immediate Past Chairman shall have copies of any Committee minutes for their information for the period of their immediate Past Chairmanship, after ratification.
- 24. Only members of the Committee may sit in at any Committee meeting, with the exception of a Minute Secretary where necessary, or any person who is invited by the Committee to speak in connection with an Agenda item, who must then withdraw following the conclusion of that business.
- 25. All Officers and Committee members may speak and vote on any subject under discussion by the Committee and in the event of a tied vote the Chairman has a second or casting vote.
- 26. The Committee must not divulge the names and addresses of Centre members or correspondence of the Centre or Club.
- 27. In the event of a rallier/member having a complaint against the behavior of any other rallier or member and they are unable to resolve it themselves, they are to direct their complaint to the rally officers, who with the assistance of any attending Committee members should attempt to resolve the situation. If unresolved, a written report must be submitted to the full Committee by all parties concerned. If any complaint is against any Rally Officer or Committee member, the complainant should initially make a direct approach to the person concerned and if unresolved put their complaint in writing to either the Secretary or Chairman.
- 28. Any other complaints or views on any other subject should be put in writing, addressed to the Secretary, to be considered at the next Committee meeting, to which the sender will receive a written reply.
- 29. An inventory of all property belonging to the Centre shall be taken by the appropriate Officers prior to the AGM, and a copy submitted to the Treasurer at the AGM. Decisions for all repairs and replacements shall be made by the Committee and the inventory amended accordingly for that year.
- 30. A Charity Year may be held for one year during the term of office of the Chairman, if the Chairman so desires. The Chairman is to choose the Charity, to be supported.
- 31. First time rally plaques are only to be given to Cumbria Centre members, usually on their first Cumbria Centre rally.
- 32. A Rally Programme will be sent to members registered at 31st December of the preceding year to which the new Programme refers and to new members when the Secretary receives from The Club notification of their Centre membership. If a Centre membership has lapsed, then a rally Programme will be sent to that member on re-registration with the Centre.
- 33. Only one free Rally Book will be issued annually to each full Cumbria Centre member, who has attended at least one rally in the preceding year. Rally Books may be purchased from the Treasurer at a price fixed by The Committee.
- 34. At the age of 16 a child is deemed to be an adult for social activities.

Northern Region Booking Conditions

Durham:

Require a £5 deposit for weekend rallies that are limited, paid directly to the rally marshal. There is a £5 deposit for bank holiday rallies. The balance of the rally should be paid by cash on arrival. On rallies of 5 days more a deposit of £10.00 is required when booking. This may be refundable less administration costs from the rally marshal. The appropriate fee must be paid by 6 weeks before commencement of the rally. If not paid by the 6-week point, cancellation of reserved place will be assumed, no reminder will be given. There will be a cancellation fee of £5 on all bank holidays and holiday rallies of 5 days and less.

East Yorkshire:

Require £2.00 deposit for weekend rallies and £5.00 for extended rallies with booking slip.

North Lancashire and South Lancashire:

Require you to obtain a booking form from their rally secretary, then the full fees must be sent with the booking.

Mid West Yorkshire:

£5.00 deposit with booking form. Membership number must be quoted on slips.

Northumberland:

No booking payment required except for holiday, limited space or charity rallies. For these the full fee is required. If the booking is cancelled after the Tuesday prior to the rally a £2.00 fee will be paid to the rally secretary. No bookings for limited rallies will be accepted before the 1st February 2020.

North Yorkshire:

£2.00 booking fee

Yorkshire Pennine:

No booking fee except for holiday rallies when a £5 deposit is required. If a rally is cancelled less than 7 days before the event then there is a fee of £3.00 payable, plus any costs incurred.

South Yorkshire:

Require a £3.00 Advanced Booking Fee (Non-refundable) with booking slip. Unless cancelled one calendar month prior to the rally.

Yorkshire Dales:

No booking fee required for 2 nights' duration. Unless cancelled 7 days in advance, there will be an administration fee of £3.00 plus any expenses incurred. In the case of a limited rally that was full, shall pay the full rally fee. In exceptional circumstances these charges may be waived at the discretion of the Committee. For rallies of more than 3 nights a deposit of 30% minimum of the rally fee is required, unless individual booking details apply.

Never Rallied Before?

Thank you for being part of Cumbria Centre. We would like to welcome you to the centre and hope that you enjoy reading this programme of rallies that has been put together for the coming season.

So, what is a Rally?

Many of our centre members have never joined us on a rally and maybe this is because the word 'rally' conjures up so many different images. Yes, there are words only heard within the 'rallying world' i.e. Flag, but these words are the the foundation of what a rally is. ('Flag' is an informal and optional gathering at the start and end of the rally where tea, coffee and conversation flow.) What a rally involves is explained below.

What kinds of Rally are there?

All of our rallies have their own individual character. Some are quiet affairs with no organised activities. Other rallies have socials and activities organised which may be in the local village hall or on the field in summer. All activities are completely open and we want you to feel free to join in, it is entirely up to you. Activities range from traditional to new and you will receive a warm welcome every time.

How does it work?

On arriving at the rally, you will be welcomed on to site by the Rally Officer and directed to your pitch. You will be given the programme for the rally and an optional competition or quiz. Usually on the first evening of the rally, there will be an opportunity to join the 'flag'. You are then free to enjoy the rally as much as you like. The rally office is always on hand if you have questions.

The rally will be 'closed' on the final day with another 'flag' and awarding of competition prizes. Rally Officers also take this time to update you on forthcoming events and centre news. After all, its your centre!

The centre you belong to gives you a fantastic opportunity to experience the locations the rally officers have found. Whether it be for picturesque landscapes where you can spend the time relaxing or a location near to great shopping opportunities. The simpler rallies are often exceptional value for money with nominal fees charged but increasingly, rallies are held on 'Club Sites' and other commercial sites – often at large discounts from normal rates.

How do I book or get more information?

The best place to start is to contact the Rally Secretary or the Rally Officer listed for the rally you are interested in. They will be able to guide you through making your booking and give you any further information you need.



EXTRA INFORMATION REGARDING GRASMERE EASTER

Dear Rallier,

After last year's success, we are excited to be holding a 10 day holiday rally again this year at Grasmere, the rally

STARTS at 12pm Friday and FINISHES at 2pm on Bank Holiday Monday.

At the point of creating this booking form (November 2019) we are currently anticipating using the Stocks Lane entrance on to the rally field, like we did last year. We will be operating a one way system around the field going clockwise throughout the whole rally. Like last year, we anticipate that there will be arrivals and departures on a daily basis. We request that all visitors are advised of the one way system prior to arrival and we must stress that it is **strictly 5mph** on site (**that's 1st gear!!**).

Battery charging will be available but PLEASE bring a charger if you have one, but not for electric/hybrid cars.

Over recent years many people have run out of gas. There are limited supplies in the area, particularly over Easter, so please come prepared (especially if you're joining us for the full 10 nights).

EASTER EGG HUNT is planned for Easter Sunday, along with the sales of bacon butties which were well received last year. Please detail any interest for the hunt on the booking form so we can buy the Eggs. Please note there will be a small charge for the Egg Hunt to cover costs.

<u>VISITORS</u> If you are expecting visitors they must adhere to the one way system and the <u>5mph speed limit</u> which will take them past the Rally Office where they can announce their arrival to whoever is 'on duty' (only courtesy). Their cars may be parked alongside your pitch (weather permitting).

TOWING OUT As many of you are aware the field can get very wet very quickly, but equally so, it drains and dries out quickly. As we ask you to just back off the track, traction for most vehicles is maintained by keeping the car on the track whilst positioning. IF your CAR becomes stuck, we along with other ralliers, will probably be able to help push you out. Please be aware we are not insured to tow your car or caravan with our own vehicles. We would ask that if you are in a **motorhome/campervan** then please can you bring with you matting etc. that can give you traction if you are stuck on the grass, although the new area may negate the need.
